



Select the College Readiness Courseware from the Products navigation menu on the dashboard.


4. Beginning Study

5. Pretest Navigation




To begin, select **Pretest** from a module title.

After the initial instructions, you will begin the **Pretest**. A learner must complete the pretest in order to begin the course.




Navigate through the introduction by clicking the Back and Next buttons. Then click Exit to return to the CRC+ hompage. From the homepage click Pretest, then click Start to begin the module pretest.



Answer each question and click **Submit** to move forward.

If learners score 80% or better on the pretest, they can advance directly to the posttest. However, it is recommended that all learners complete the courseware prior to attempting the posttest.

6. Course Navigation



On the homepage, click Course to enter the module of study.



Navigate through the course by clicking the **Back** and **Next** buttons. After completing the course, click **Exit** to return to the CRC+ hompage. Learners can now advance to the **Posttest**.

Scores of 80% or better on each module posttest earns a learner an eBadge for that unit of study. A Math certificate of completion is earned when the modules of Pre-Algebra, Algebra and Geometry are completed successfully. A Language Arts certificate of completion is earned when proficiency is documented in the Reading and Writing/English modules.
